This summer, one of the things we will be thinking about at First Lutheran Church is outreach. As God's people, how are we inviting,



involving, equipping, and empowering others to serve so that all may know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior? The answer is in many ways.

Our LWR quilts, School kits, layettes, and sustainable feminine products are some of the first things that come to mind. We also provide food for the Rock Food Pantry as the bin in the narthex is often full. A special shout out to Gail M. for often being our hauling minister for this outreach!

We have turned the former **Pastor's Discretionary** Fund into the **On the Road with Jesus Fund** in the last year. Through this fund and the help of our friends at The Mobile in Gladstone, we provide three \$50 "Fuel Only" gift certificates a month to folks needing help getting to work or doctor's appointments. We will help each family up to three times a year.

Our efforts have not gone unnoticed. Other churches have started referring individuals in need of fuel to us, a testament to the impact of our ministry. Every person we assist also receives an invitation to worship with us; some have even joined us on Sundays. However, the **On the Road** with Jesus funds are running low. If you have the means to contribute, we encourage you to share your blessings with the community. You can do so through the Vanco App on our website or by check. We also continue our outreach by serving Bay College Meals.

Our monthly giving envelopes have supported Walk for Warmth, LWR, World Hunger, FLLC Camperships, and Grace to Ukraine. They will also go towards Mission of Hope, Kiwanis Backpacks, Mkuza Girl's School, Gladstone Public Library, Operation Christmas Child, Lakestate Industries, and The Seminary Fund at First.

We invite local youth to our Fortune Lake Day Camp. I preach at Bishop Noa's protestant service several times a year; this listing is just the tip of the iceberg. Reaching out is our mission and calling here at First Lutheran Church. Thank you for looking out for our brothers and sisters in the Gladstone area and beyond. God is using our gifts for good.

The next meeting is scheduled for *Sunday, August 4th at 9:00 am* in the double classroom.

Safety Task Force

The Safety committee was asked by the Policy committee to look at the Chemical Storage and need for SDS. A preliminary search indicated there is no need for one at First Lutheran.

Signs were posted for all the doors, except at the main entrance, "PLEASE USE DOUBLE DOORS ON MINN. AVE. DURING OFFICE HOURS AND WORSHIP. An usher light was set up and is working for the ushers to see when someone is at the main entrance waiting to get in. Ray Miller was able to get First Lutheran special "Gas Only" gift certificates for our "On the Road with Jesus" fund. The committee's concerns about the Council's conversation on renting out church space continues to be addressed. Howard spoke with some city staff about zoning. The next Safety Committee Meeting will be on *August 6th*, at 1:00 pm.
